

INTERLAKE HIGH SCHOOL PTSA 2010 SCHOLARSHIP

The Interlake High School PTSA will be awarding one Interlake PTSA Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. The recipient will be a graduating senior who plans to continue their education at an accredited college, university, technical or trade school. Application forms may be obtained from the Counselor's Office or printed from the Interlake High School PTSA website.

Prerequisites:

1. The applicant **MUST** have attended Interlake High School for two years and be an Interlake High School Senior graduating in June 2010.
2. The applicant **MUST** have at least a 2.5 grade point average (cumulative).
3. All application submission requirements and any attachments, including the required signatures must be submitted as one package. Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Applicants are encouraged to use the specified format.
4. Scholarship money must be applied to tuition or room and board at an accredited college, university, technical or trade school during the 2010-2011 academic school year.
5. The scholarship check will be made payable to the school for the recipient's account.
6. Taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the recipient.
7. If the scholarship recipient does not accept their scholarship or does not graduate, the scholarship will be awarded to another applicant chosen by the scholarship committee.
8. Application must be returned to the Interlake High School Scholarship Box in the Interlake High School Counseling Center by **3:00pm on Monday, April 19, 2010**.

Judging:

The scholarship recipient will be selected on the basis of a statement of development as a student and citizen, participation in school and community activities, academic record, potential to succeed, and on outside appraisal.

Recipient Notification:

Recipient and all other applicants will be notified by May 10, 2010. Award of scholarship is subject to recipient submitting verification of enrollment in an accredited institution for the 2010-2011 school year. An award certificate will be presented at both the Interlake PTSA General Membership meeting May 27, 2010 and at the Interlake Senior Awards Night.

Funding:

Funds for this scholarship are raised annually by the Interlake High School PTSA.
